

## What is the FAST CAT?

FAST CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch area. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed with they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per hour (MPH). Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to, but less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0

## NEW RULE EFFECTIVE AS OF: Aug 25, 2018

### Section 14. HANDLERS.

Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run.

A handler may call, cheer, clap for their dog from the run out. It does add some excitement to the run!

A handler may NOT run down the course with their dog. No one can run down the outside of the course to entice the dog to run.

A handler may NOT use toys/treats from the run out to entice the dog to run to them. They MAY use toys/treats in the run out when the dog is finished.

A handler MAY walk down the track to the run out BEFORE the dog is released. They need to be in the run out before the dog is released.

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 Points

FCAT = 1,000 Points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

## Conditions of Entry

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form. All tests can be listed on the same form for the one dog. A returned check is not a valid entry. There will be a \$35 fee for a returned check. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. FAST Cat events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

At roll call, ALL dogs will be examined for disqualifications. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will excused with entry monies refunded, **minus a \$10.00 fee.**

## Prizes

MOTC will offer a light blue ribbon for a qualifying run.  
New Title ribbons for any dog earning their FAST CAT title at this event.

## Hours

Grounds will be available at 7:00 AM. Roll call and exhibitor briefing will begin at 7:30 AM. For the morning test and 30 minutes after the morning test has been completed for the afternoon test. MOTC will make every attempt to facilitate that all entrants will be accommodated with regard to running their dogs in the trials, BUT it is also the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line.

Day of test entries accepted as space allows. Entries will be acknowledged by email IF legible email address is provided in entry form. Entries must be received by November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018

### **MOTC Trial Information**

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade, chairs and water
- An electronic timing system will be used.
- A battery powered, continuous loop lure equipment will be used.
- Lure will consist of white plastic bags
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced
- Dogs MUST BE on lead or crated unless running
- **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after your dog**
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and Children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form. One form for the weekend.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded minus \$10.00
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve their dog on the course
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/MOTC, any dog(s), other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, may be disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**
